

The Corporation of the City of Pembroke

By-law Number 2018-15

A By-law to amend By-law 2016-25, as amended, being a by-law to establish rules and regulations for the licensing and operation of taxicabs within the City of Pembroke

Whereas Section 156(1) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, states that a local municipality, in a by-law under Section 151 with respect to the owners and drivers of taxicabs may establish the rates or fares to be charged for the conveyance of property or passengers either wholly within the municipality or from any point in the municipality to any point outside the municipality; provide for the collection of the rates or fares charged for the conveyance; and limit the number of taxicabs or any class of them;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2016-25, being a by-law to establish rules and regulations for the licensing and operation of taxicabs;

Now Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "B" – Taxicab of By-law 2016-25 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:
 1. Minimum fee of three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75).
 2. A basic fee of three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75).
 4. After the first kilometer each one/twenty-second (1/22) kilometer or any part thereof: ten cents (.10¢).
 7. Flat Rates:
 - Edwards Mazda to West End and points in between: seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50).
 - Pembroke Mall to Spruce Street at Drive-in Road and points in between: six dollars and thirty cents (\$6.30).
 - Valley Automotive to PEM-Ice II and points in between: seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50).
2. That Schedule "B" – Taxicab of By-law 2016-25 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 1. Minimum fee of four dollars and sixty cents (\$4.60).
 2. A basic fee of four dollars and sixty cents (\$4.60).
 3. After the first kilometer, each kilometer thereafter shall be two dollars and ninety cents (\$2.90).
3. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.
4. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
